

Year 7 2027 Admission

Thank you for applying for enrolment for Year 7 2027. Applications close on **31 May 2025**. The following information will help families prepare for the process. Please mark these events in your calendar and we will be in contact closer to the date.

Please be aware that due to the high number of applicants and a limited number of positions available, applications will be shortlisted based on priority (e.g. siblings of current students) and time spent on waitlist. Please refer to our Terms of Enrolment, [available on our website](#) for more information.

You've applied, what now?

Families will receive communication to confirm if they have been shortlisted by **Friday 6 June 2025**. Being shortlisted does not guarantee enrolment as the College will be interviewing more students than places available. Families not shortlisted will be communicated with and will remain on the waiting list until a future opportunity arises to progress in the process.

Once shortlisted, what happens next?

1. Complete Student Information Form.

The Student Information Form is the first step of the process, it will be emailed to parents who have completed an application. Forms will be emailed on or after Friday 6 June and need to be submitted by **Friday 13 June**.

2. Attend Admission Testing

As part of the enrolment process, all applicants will be required to sit an Admissions Test. This test is a compulsory part of the process and will only occur on one day. The test will be conducted on **Monday 30 June** and will last for approximately 50mins. You'll be allocated to one of the two sessions scheduled; one at 8.45am and one 10.30am. The general ability testing is for school purposes and will not be shared with students/parents. Further details with a confirmed time of testing for each student will be provided at a later date.

3. Provide required supporting documents.

The College will require supporting documents for your application, this includes a copy of:

- Semester 2 2024 report
- Semester 1 2025 report
- Year 5 NAPLAN results (if available)
- Health plans, assessments and other documents

Documents need to be provided electronically to Admissions@aitkencollege.edu.au by **Friday 25 July 2025**. Please reference the student name and ID when sending documents.

4. Attend an Admission Interview

Enrolment interviews will only be conducted on the evenings of **Tuesday 12 August and Tuesday 19 August 2025**. Interviews will be conducted at the College and will take approximately 20 minutes. This is an opportunity for the College to meet and get to know families. A confirmed interview time will be sent to parents via email closer to date.

5. Enrolment application outcomes

Once all interviews are conducted, the outcome will be communicated on **Friday 12 September 2025**.

Successful applicants will receive an Enrolment Offer, which will need to be completed and returned by the due date therein. Unsuccessful applications will also receive communication with the option to remain on the waitlist.

Dates to note:

- Complete Student Information form online by 13 June 2025 (link will be provided early June).
- Attend Admission testing day on 30 June 2025.
- Provide supporting documents by 25 July 2025.
- Attend Admission interview on 12 or 19 August 2025.
- Outcomes will be confirmed on 12 September 2025.
