

Year Prep 2026 Admission

Thank you for applying for enrolment for Year Prep 2026. Applications close on **31 March 2025**. The following information will help families prepare for the process. Please mark these events in your calendar and we will be in contact closer to the date.

Please be aware that due to the high number of applicants and a limited number of positions available, applications will be shortlisted based on priority (e.g. siblings of current students) and time spent on waitlist. Please refer to our Terms of Enrolment, [available on our website](#) for more information.

You've applied, what now?

Families will receive communication to confirm if they have been shortlisted by **Friday 4 April 2025**. Being shortlisted does not guarantee enrolment as the College will be interviewing more students than places available. Families not shortlisted will be communicated with and will remain on the waiting list until a future opportunity arises to progress in the process.

Once shortlisted, what happens next?

1. Complete Student Information Form.

Shortlisted families will be invited to an interview and will be emailed with a Student Information Form to complete.

Families that are not shortlisted will be communicated with and remain on the waiting list for future opportunities.

2. Provide required supporting documents.

The College will require supporting documents for your application, this includes a copy of:

- Proof of Immunisation status (From Medicare)
- Health plans, assessments and other documents relevant to your child's needs.

Documents need to be provided electronically to admissions@aitkencollege.edu.au by **11 April 2025**. Please reference the student's name and ID when sending documents.

3. Attend an Admission Interview

Enrolment interviews will be conducted throughout April and May. This is an opportunity for the College to meet and get to know families. Dates and times will be emailed to parents once confirmed. Interviews will be conducted at the College and will take approximately 30 minutes.

4. Enrolment application outcomes

Once all interviews are conducted, the outcome will be communicated by the end of May.

Successful applicants will receive an Enrolment Offer, which will need to be completed and returned by the due date therein. Unsuccessful applications will also receive communication with the option to remain on the waitlist.
