

Jevon joined the College staff in 2019 and is currently the Head of Year One and Two in the Primary School. He may also be familiar to some students and families as one of the Primary Performing Arts teachers, where he has worked closely with younger students in developing their skills in performance.

Shrek the Musical marks Jevon's directorial debut of an annual College Musical and he has relished the opportunity to be working with the senior students of Aitken, which is always a rewarding experience.

Across his past five years with the College, Jevon has assisted with staging a variety of concerts, plays and musicals including *Spamalot* (2019), *The Addams Family* (2021) and *Alice in Wonderland* (2022).

Further to his experience at Aitken, Jevon has previously directed musicals across several schools and community theatre organisations. During his time at Cobram Anglican Grammar School, Jevon staged the inaugural production of *Legally Blonde* (2016), followed by *Annie* (2017), successfully creating a much-needed performing arts culture in the school and wider community.

Other favourite directorial credits include *The Wedding Singer* for Numurkah Singers (2018) and *Little Shop of Horrors* for OPTC (2010).

Whilst Jevon now tends to focus his energies on working behind the scenes, he is no stranger to the stage himself, having played the role of Doctor Dillamond in hit musical (and personal favourite) *Wicked* with Shepparton Theatre (2018).



Donna began teaching at Aitken College in 2022 and is currently a Grade 2 teacher as well as teaching Performing Arts. Donna had taught Performing Arts for 8 years at her previous school.

Donna started dancing at the age of 5 and she studied jazz, tap, ballet and contemporary. After competing in a range of competitions over the years she turned her attention to completing her exams. She started teaching classes at the age of 15 and in 2004 she

received her tap teaching diploma through the Commonwealth Society of Teachers of Dancing (COMDANCE).

Donna performed several times with her dance school, taking on the roles of Lumiere in *Beauty and the Beast* and Mufasa in *The Lion King*. She also had the opportunity to perform back up for Lisa McCune on television for the *Royal Children's Hospital Good Friday Appeal* and she got to tap dance in the Myer Windows as part of a tap festival.

In 2011, she partnered up with her friend and fellow dance teacher to open her own dance school 'R & D Dancers.' In 2013 and 2016 Donna took several students to the USA where they performed at Disneyland, Disneyworld and Universal Studios. They also participated in a series of workshops with industry professionals.

Having choreographed many performances for primary aged students, this is Donna's first time choreographing a secondary school musical and she has enjoyed working with such talented staff and students.

Set in a magical kingdom of fairytale creatures, Shrek the Musical follows the grumpy and misunderstood ogre named Shrek, whose life is turned upside down when the villainous Lord Farquaad banishes all the fairytale creatures to Shrek's swamp. Determined to reclaim his peace and quiet, Shrek strikes a deal with Farquaad to rescue Princess Fiona, who is trapped in a tower guarded by a fiery and fierce dragon. Along the way, Shrek encounters an exuberant and talkative Donkey, who quickly becomes Shrek's unwilling companion on this unexpected journey. As Shrek and Donkey venture through perilous challenges and comedic misadventures, they discover that Fiona herself is harbouring a secret. When the sun sets, Fiona transforms into an ogre, just like Shrek! As they journey back to Farquaad, Shrek and Fiona grow closer, forging an unlikely romance as they navigate the complexities of love, friendship, and self-acceptance. Meanwhile, Lord Farquaad's devious intentions are revealed, and he is determined to marry Fiona to fulfill his own twisted ambitions of becoming king. With the help of their newfound allies, including the sassy Dragon and a group of misfit fairytale creatures, Shrek and Fiona must confront their own insecurities and face their fears to save their fairytale friends and find true happiness.


